Description

The Dromex® MAC rain protective attire is a reflective, light weight, thermal and durable water-resistant jacket and pants suit that protects the body and undergarments from the hazards of rain and water splashes.

The MAC rain jacket is extremely breathable due to the aeration holes construction that allows sweat vapor to escape whilst the inner flannel lining provides a comfortable balance of warmth and breathability without excessive heat buildup, suitable for a wider range of temperatures and activities.

The MAC jacket design consists of the following:

- · A stow away fixed hood with an adjustable drawstring.
- Reflective tape on arms, chest and back.
- A high stand collar.
- 2 Large waist pockets with a storm flap for ample storage of gloves, tools, etc.
- A heavy-duty full non-metal zip front.
- Drawstring closure at the bottom of the jacket.
- Adjustable press stud closure on sleeve cuff that prevents water from running down your sleeve.

The MAC trousers are elasticated at the waist with reflective tape above the ankle's and press stud closures on the ankle for improved comfortable fit and seal when worn with safety protective footwear such as gumboots.

All seams are double stitched with PVC (Polyvinyl chloride) and heat-pressed for enhanced water resistance.

Suitable for applications where there is exposure to rain, used in general mining, outdoor and contractor applications.

Special Instructions

None of the materials or processes used in the manufacture of these products are known to be harmful to the wearer.

The manufacturer has examined under the system for ensuring quality of production by means of monitoring and inspection.

These rain suits are designed to accommodate the basic safety requirements and standards for Personal Protective Equipment.

The information contained herein is intended to assist the wearer in the selection of personal protective equipment.

Actual conditions of use cannot be directly simulated in a test environment therefore it is the responsibility of the end user and not the manufacturer or supplier to determine the rain suits suitability for the intended use. Keep clear of open flames.

All rain suits should be thoroughly inspected before and after use to ensure no damage is present.

Style: Navy blue, 2-piece rain suit, vented with waist length

jacket and elasticated pants, stored in a re-sealable bag

with zip closure.

Fabric composition: 50 % PVC / 50 % Polyester 190T.

Inner lining: T/C 65/35 Flannel.

Material fasteners: Metal zip with POM (Polyoxymethylene) zipper and

PP (polypropylene) press studs.

Material drawstrings: Polypropylene.

Material evelets: Iron

Reflective tape: 25mm Retro - reflective tape.

Mass: 160gsm.

Compliancy & Conformity

This rain suit is designed for protection against foul weather increments only. The garment meets the requirements of PPE regulation 2016/425 for ergonomics, harmless materials, comfort, aeration and flexibility as well as the water tightness of the garment.

Packaging, Storage & Obsolescence

The standard packaging for the rain suits are as follows. Each rain suit is packed in resealable storage bag with zip closure. Store the rain suits in the original packaging in a cool dry place and out of direct sunlight.

Cleaning & Maintenance

Rain suits should not be left in a contaminated condition if re-use is intended especially if potential hazards exist.

Rain suits should be decontaminated before storage and re-use as indicated below:



Do not machine wash.

Do not bleach as the garment is not colourfast or structurally designed to withstand any bleach.

Do not iron.

This garment may not be commercially dry-cleaned. Cleaning of this garment is best done using a mild detergent with deodoriser, wipe clean wipe dry or air dry.

Disposal

All industrial waste should be disposed of correctly according to local regulations and good disposal practice. Rain suits should be disposed of considering the hazardous substances they were used for. Please consider recycling.
